Darren Farm Development and weight limit through Llysworney: The Clerk reported that he had received a copy of the section 106 agreement between the landowners and the VGCBC which detailed the terms, notably a contribution of £950,000 that had been included for "sustainable transport". Cllr. C. Cave gave an update regarding the link road to the A48 which the developers are bringing forward ahead of schedule and suggested that a meeting between Ms. C. Pugh, Mr. M. Clogg and Council would be pertinent at this juncture. All agreed that this was a positive step and Cllr. Cave kindly agreed to arrange for them to attend the February meeting of Council, if possible. It was also agreed to bring the meeting forward to 7 pm to facilitate this arrangement.
