#### 146/88 POLICE REPORT:

PCSO Stone relayed (by email) that there had been one incident reported in the previous month: theft of pots in the Llysworney area.

PCSO Stone requested (by email) that anyone interested in participating in 'Community Speed Watch' should email her directly and she would make the necessary arrangements.

#### 147/18. MATTERS ARISING:

*Brook at Llandow:* Cllr. A. Pattinson reported that the brook was now running normally. Apparently, the problem was caused by the very low water table, following an unusually hot, dry summer; however, the issue had been resolved by the recent heavy rainfall.

*Noise from Race Track:* The Clerk confirmed that residents should register their concerns directly with VGCBC so that they can take matters forward.

Darren Farm Development and weight limit through Llysworney: It was noted that construction work is well underway at Darren Farm, with the footprint of the main road through the development being clearly visible. It was always understood that, once the new road opened, a weight limit would be applied to the B4268 through Llysworney, from its junction with the A48 at Pentre Meyrick to the junction with the B4270 at Nash. Llysworney Community Association has contacted Alun Cairns MP regarding this matter and Cllr. J. Shaw reported that she had been in touch with VGCBC. The Clerk was advised to request a copy of the Section 106 agreement and Council agreed to monitor the situation and keep pressing for a weight limit through Llysworney and alterations to the junction at Nash to be made as soon as possible.
